Aim

To speedily and efficiently assist new and existing business entities, of foreign interests, to establish a company in Cyprus

Fast Track Business Activation Mechanism SERVICES PROVIDED

ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPANIES

Establishment of a business from a single point of contact, including: Company registration and name approval, and registration with the Social Insurance Registry, the Employers Registry, the VAT Registry and Income Tax

LICENSING OF OPERATIONS

Provision of information and guidance for obtaining all permits required in order to start operations





EMPLOYMENT AND RESIDENCE

Facilitating the issuance of residence and employment permits in Cyprus for third country nationals



BENEFITS FOR FOREIGN COMPANIES ENTERING THE MECHANISM

- > Completion of procedures for setting up a company within 7 days from the day the company enters the Mechanism
- > Issuance of residence and employment permits within 4-6 weeks, depending on the number of permits requested
- > Employment of a greater number of third country nationals in specific professions and with specialised skills, for which a shortage of supply has been identified at national level, with the majority being related to digital skills





Fast Track Business Activation Mechanism **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Companies interested to enter the Fast Track Business Activation Mechanism should meet qualitative and quantitative criteria, thus contributing positively to the country's economic growth







Fast Track Business Activation Mechanism ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



PHYSICAL PRESENCE

Companies must have or establish a physical presence in Cyprus, with the operation of independent offices



EXISTING COMPANIES

Minimum turnover of €500.000 per year, for 3 out of the last 5 years





NEW COMPANIES

Submission of a comprehensive 5-year business plan, showing growth potential



Submission of Application

Submission of application to the Ministry of Energy, Commerce and Industry, accompanied by:

- A letter of expression of interest in establishing presence in Cyprus
- Certificate of Incorporation,
 Shareholder Certificate,
 Directors Certificate and Articles of
 Association

Audited Financial Accounts for 3 of the last 5 years or 5-year business plan (for a new company)





Evaluation Procedure

Evaluation of applications by an authorized 3-member Committee:

- > Due Diligence Checks
- Evaluation of submitted
 documents (financial statements,
 business plan)
- Inform interested company on entry/rejection


